august 15-18: The Woodward Dream Cruise is the world's largest one-day automotive event, drawing over 1-million people and 40,000 classic cars each year from as far away as Australia and Japan.

The actual cruise takes place on 8/17 but there are events going on the whole week leading up to it. Ford is a major sponsor of the event including Mustang Alley, a special parking area in Ferndale MI. We are also hoping to line up a few private collection/museum/plant tours for 8/15 & 16.

Sunday 8/18 is the legendary Mustang Memories show which takes place at Ford World Headquarters in Dearborn. Run by the 900 member Mustang Owners Club of Southeast Michigan (MOCSEM) it is one of the largest Ford shows of the year, drawing over 800 cars. With this being Mustang's 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary, that number could be even higher.
